THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF INDIANA'S MOTION TO STRIKE THE APPEARANCES AND COMPLAINT FILED ON BEHALF OF THE PLAINTIFF

Gregory F. Zoeller, Attorney General, by Kenneth L. Joel, and David A. Arthur Deputies Attorney General, respectfully moves the Court to strike the appearances and complaint filed by Plaintiff Glenda Ritz's counsel and states in support:

1. On October 22, 2013, Plaintiff, Glenda Ritz, in her official capacity as Chair of the Indiana State Board of Education and Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction, sued the members of the Indiana Board of Education "in their individual capacities as members of the Indiana State Board of Education, and George Angelone in his official

- capacity as Director of Legislative Services Agency, seeking declaratory and injunctive relief under Ind. Trial Rule 57, Indiana Code chs. 5-14-1.5, 34-14-1 and 34-26-1.
- Attorneys Bernice A. N. Corely and Michael G. Moore filed the Complaint on behalf of Plaintiff Glenda Ritz.
- 3. Indiana Code § 4-6-2-1 provides, in part: "[the] attorney-general shall prosecute and defend all suits that may be instituted by or against the state of Indiana."
- 4. Without the consent of the Attorney General, no state official may hire or utilize private counsel to represent herself in an official capacity suit. See State ex rel. Sendak v. Marion County Superior Court, Room No. 2, 373 N.E.2d 145, 148 (Ind. 1978) (citing State ex rel. Young v. Niblack, 229 Ind. 596, 603, 99 N.E.2d 839, 841 (Ind. 1951) ("when the suit involves State officers or employees in their official capacities, the outside attorney may only act as an amicus curiae unless the Attorney General consents."
- 5. "No agency, except as provided in this act [Indiana Code Section 4-6-5-1 through Indiana Code Section 4-6-5-6] shall have any right to name, appoint, employ or hire any attorney, or special or general counsel to represent it or perform any legal service in behalf of such agency and the state without the written consent of the attorney-general." Matter of Prop. Located at Marriott Inn, 505 Marriott Drive, Clarksville, Ind., 456 N.E.2d 444, 446 (Ind. Ct. App. 1983).
- 6. Therefore, as Chair of the Indiana State Board of Education and Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction, the representation of Plaintiff Ritz's legal interests lies exclusively in the hands of the Attorney General.

6. The Attorney General has not authorized attorneys Bernice A.N. Corely and Michael G.

Moore to appear on behalf of the State of Indiana, and any appearances should be

stricken.

7. Absent such authorization, Indiana law prohibits the Chair of the Indiana State Board of

Education and Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction in her official capacity to

employ counsel to seek declaratory and/or injunctive relief.

8. Because attorneys Bernice A.N. Corely and Michael G. Moore have no authority to

represent the Plaintiff in her official capacity, their appearances should be stricken,

together with the complaint signed by them.

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General respectfully requests that the Court:

1) Strike the appearances, if any, of attorneys Bernice A. N. Corely and Michael G. Moore

entered on behalf of Plaintiff, Glenda Ritz;

2) Strike the Complaint signed by attorneys Bernice A. N. Corely and Michael G. Moore;

and

3) Grant the Attorney General all other relief just and proper in the premises.

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF INDIANA'S MOTION TO STRIKE THE APPEARANCES AND COMPLAINT FILED ON BEHALF OF THE PLAINTIFF

.A. Introduction

Plaintiff, Glenda Ritz, in her official capacity as Chair of the Indiana State Board of Education and Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction ("State Plaintiff"), has filed a Complaint for declaratory and injunctive relief against sued the members of the Indiana Board of Education "in their individual capacities as members of the Indiana State Board of Education, and George Angelone in his official capacity as Director of Legislative Services Agency, seeking declaratory and injunctive relief under Ind. Trial Rule 57, Indiana Code chs. 5-14-1.5, 34-14-1 and 34-26-1" (hereinafter collectively referred to as "State Defendants").

In furtherance of this action, attorneys Bernice A.N. Corely and Michael G. Moore entered their appearance on behalf of State Plaintiff. Only the Attorney General represents the interests of the State of Indiana and its officers and employees in any suits that may be instituted by or against the State of Indiana. See Indiana Code Section 4-6-2-1. Accordingly, the appearance of any other attorney purporting to appear on behalf of a State official in an official capacity should be stricken, together with any filing made by that attorney.

B. Attorneys Bernice A.N. Corely and Michael G. Moore May Not Appear on Behalf of the State Plaintiff in Her Official Capacity Without the Consent of the Attorney General

Indiana Code Section 4-6-2-1 provides in part: "[the] attorney-general shall prosecute and defend all suits that may be instituted by or against the state of Indiana." The purpose of the office of the Attorney General is "to give the State independent legal representation and to establish a general legal policy for State agencies." *Indiana State Toll Bridge Commission v. Minor*, 139 N.E.2d 445, 448 (Ind. 1957). In doing so, the Attorney General must reconcile the conflicting legal views of multiple state officials and harmonize the state's legal position before the courts. For these reasons, the legislature has chosen to vest the sole responsibility for the legal representation of the State in the Attorney General. *State ex rel. Sendak v. Marion County Superior Court, Room No. 2*, 373 N.E.2d 145, 149 (Ind. 1978).

"No agency, except as provided in this act [Indiana Code Section 4-6-5-1 through Indiana Code Section 4-6-5-6], shall have any right to name, appoint, employ or hire any attorney, or special or general counsel to represent it or perform any legal service in behalf of such agency and the state without the written consent of the attorney-general." Matter of Prop. Located at Marriott Inn, 505 Marriott Drive, Clarksville, Ind., 456 N.E.2d 444, 446 (Ind. Ct. App. 1983). In the instant case, the Attorney General has not provided written consent to attorneys Bernice

A.N. Corely and Michael G. Moore to represent State Plaintiff in the Complaint filed in her official capacity. Absent such authorization, Indiana law prohibits the Chair of the Indiana State Board of Education and Indiana Superintendent of Public Instruction in her official capacity to employ counsel to seek declaratory and/or injunctive relief.

C. Conclusion

Because there is no authority for Attorneys Bernice A.N. Corely and Michael G. Moore to appear on behalf of State Plaintiff Glenda Ritz in her official capacity, the Attorney General respectfully requests that the Court strike the appearance of Bernice A.N. Corely and Michael G. Moore and the complaint filed by them.
