

Local Disaster Emergency Declaration

Kosciusko County, Indiana

Authority

Whereas, Kosciusko County, Indiana has been impacted by or is immediately threatened by a significant winter storm on the days of January 5 & 6, 2014 resulting in extensive snowfall and aggravated by high winds and extremely cold temperatures.

Now, therefore, we, the Kosciusko County Board of Commissioners, declare that a local disaster emergency exists in the County and that we hereby invoke and declare those portions of the Indiana Code which are applicable to the conditions and have caused the issuance of this proclamation, to be in full force and effect in the County for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the people of this County and the restoration of local government with a minimum of interruption.

All travel on unincorporated roadways in the county is prohibited *except*:
To and from and in the performance of work,
Emergency Response
Other travel as directed by the Commissioners.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances, and resolutions and particularly to Indiana Code 10-14-3-29.

All public offices and employees of Kosciusko County are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in execution of emergency laws, regulations, and directives—state and local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures, to cooperate with public officials and disaster services forces in executing emergency operations plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.
